ICIS Supports our Local Government members through the CivicSpatial Grant Program

The **Town of Comox** has been awarded a grant of **\$10,000** to spatially adjust approximately 4700 parcels to newly established control points and known existing legal survey control monuments.

An accurate cadastral fabric created through this project will provide greater value to the Town of Comox for planning purposes and sharing among clients, residents, staff, and ICIS members.

The **City of Cranbrook** has been awarded a grant of **\$7,000** to establish new survey control with the assistance of GeoBC's Parcel Fabric Unit.

The Parcel Fabric Unit will be undertaking the recompilation of the existing Cranbrook data using the Parcel Fabric Unit's cadastral fabric and an additional 20 GPS Cadastral Tie survey control points. This work will also complete the Parcel Fabric Unit's fabric by including Cranbrook's recently surveyed parcels.

This project will provide Cranbrook and ICIS members with a spatially accurate and complete cadastral dataset.
