Sunshine Coast Receives CivicSpatial Grant of \$10,000

ICIS has awarded the Sunshine Coast Regional District with a \$10,000 grant through the CivicSpatial Grant Program to help increase the accuracy and currency of spatial data shared with ICIS members.

The Sunshine Coast has been steadily focused on increasing the accuracy of the 19,000 parcels within their region in collaboration with member jurisdictions, the Islands Trust, and First Nations communities to develop a seamless cadastral fabric.

By establishing a network of GPS points, the SCRCD has been working to adjust the majority of their cadastral fabric to a desired tolerance of +/- 0.15 meters. Final delivery of the adjusted fabric is expected for use by ICIS members by the end of 2010.
