## BCSpatial: 2013 in review

As another year has come and gone, we want to take a moment to look back on the achievements of 2013 relating to additions to the ICIS Cadastre and the AddressBC database. January 2013 started strong with **1,296,967 parcels** in the ICIS Cadastre and **1,027,388** address points in the AddressBC database with **124 jurisdictions** submitting via GeoShare.

The year closed with December 2013 reporting **1,688,000** parcels and **1,240,440** with **177 jurisdictions** submitting via GeoShare (make sure to check out the [GeoShare Update](#) to see who the new jurisdictions are!). This gain in numbers can be attributed to the work done by ICIS members with ICIS Operations to contribute their data via GeoShare, ensuring that the datasets in the ICIS Web Map are the best available data from source.

Such a gain in datasets is very exciting, as 2013 has seen the cadastre inch closer and closer to the estimated 1.75 million parcels in the Province. ICIS is our members, and these updated stats exemplify how the contributions of every member matters in achieving the goal of providing datasets from the entire province.
